



Easter Traditions

In western Christianity, including Roman Catholicism and Protestant denominations, the period prior to Easter holds special significance.

This period of fasting and penitence is called Lent. It begins on Ash Wednesday, and lasts for 40 days (not including Sundays).

The Sunday immediately prior to Easter is called Palm Sunday, and it commemorates Jesus's arrival in Jerusalem, when followers laid palm leaves across the road to greet him.

Many churches begin the Easter observance in the late hours of the day before (Holy Saturday) in a religious service called the Easter Vigil.

In Eastern Orthodox Christianity, Easter rituals start with the Great Lent, which begins on Clean Monday (40 days prior to Easter not including Sundays). The last week of Great Lent is referred to as Palm Week, and it ends with Lazarus Saturday, the day before Palm Sunday.

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week, which ends on Easter.

Seder Meaning


On the first two nights of Passover, families and friends gather for a religious feast known as a seder or the Jewish holiday.

During the meal, the story of the exodus from Egypt is read aloud from a special text called the Haggadah (Hebrew for "telling"), and rituals corresponding to various aspects of the narrative are performed. For example, vegetables are dipped into salt water representing the tears Jews shed during their time as slaves, and bitter herbs (usually horseradish) symbolizing the unpleasant years of their bondage or eaten.

A seder plate at the center of the table contains Passover foods with particular significance to the exodus story, including matzo, bitter herbs, a lamb shank bone and a mixture of fruit, nuts and wine known as charoset, which represents the mortar Jews used while bonding bricks as slaves in Egypt.

Other typical menu items include matzoh kugel (a pudding made from matzo and apples), poached fish patties called gefilte fish and chicken soup with matzo balls.

Children play an important role in the seder and are expected to take part in many of us customs. At one point during the meal, the youngest child present recites the four questions, which asked what distinguishes the special night from all other nights.

Easter Eggs Irrespective of denomination, there are many Easter time traditions with roots that can be traced to non-Christian and even pagan or non-religious celebrations. Many non-Christians choose to observe these traditions while essentially ignoring the religious aspect of the celebration.

Examples of non-religious Easter traditions include Easter eggs, and related games such as egg rolling an egg decorating.



It's believed that eggs represented fertility and birth in certain pagan traditions that pre-date Christianity. Egg decorating may have became part of the Easter celebration in a nod to the religious significance of Easter, i.e. Jesus' resurrection or re-birth.

Many people, mostly children, also participate in Easter egg "hunts", in which decorated eggs are hidden. Perhaps the most famous Easter tradition for children is the annual White House Easter Egg Roll, when children wrote Easter eggs down Capitol Hill.



The Short-Lived Pony Express

On April 3, 1860, two horseback riders left simultaneously, one

from St. Joseph, Missouri, heading west, and the other from Sacramento, California, heading east. After 10 days of relay-team riding and 1,800 miles, riders arrived at both locations bearing mail packets. The mail had never been so speedy, and the legend of the Pony Express was born.

The Pony Express debuted before the advent

of radio or telephone, when California was cut

off from the rest of the country. Any mail sent from the east arrived by ship or stagecoach several months later. In this world, the arrival

of a letter in 10 days' time was lightning fast.

HAPPY PASSOVER

The Pony Express was conceived by three owners of a freight business: William H. Russell, William Bradford Waddell, and Alexander Majors. They, along with route superintendent Benjamin Ficklin, devised a route of over 150 relay stations set up across the frontier through Missouri, Kansas, Nebraska, Wyoming, Colorado, Utah, Nevada, and California. Riders, who carried up

to 20 pounds of mail, were changed every 100 miles, with their horses switched out every 10 to

15 miles. Over 400 horses were purchased and multiple relay stations built and staffed for the endeavor. Speed was the key to the success


of the Pony Express, with their fastest delivery being news of the election of President Abraham Lincoln in a record five days' time. However,

as telegraph lines began to move westward, the need for the Pony Express began to dissipate. On October 24, 1861, a mere 18 months after

its historic first run. the Ponv Express was discontinued as the first transcontinental telearaph line was completed. Despite its brief existence. the Ponv Express

Passover and Easter

Notably, Easter is also associated with the Jewish holiday of Passover, as well as the exodus of the Jews from Egypt, as described in the Old Testament. These links are clearly seen in the Last Supper, which occurred the night before Jesus' arrest and the sufferings Jesus endured following his arrest.



These rituals would come to symbolize the sacrifice he was about to make in death, and became the basis for the Christian ritual of Holy Communion, which remains a fundamental part of Christian religious services.

As Jesus' arrest and execution were said to have occurred during the Jewish observance of Passover, the Easter holiday is often close to the former celebration on the Judeo-Christian calendar.




